Grants Request Criteria.

The following guidelines are to be given to prospective donation requestees.

They outline the criteria that the Parish Council will apply when reviewing a donation request, in order to comply with the relevant law.

- 1) Any group, club, organisation within the Parish, directly of benefit to parishioners, or supplying a charitable service to parishioners.
- 2) Any group club, organisation, local to the parish (within 5 miles), directly of benefit to parishioners, or supplying a charitable service to parishioners. Evidence of this should be provided.
- 3) Any group, club, organisation, local to the county, which has facilities of benefit to parishioners, or supplying a charitable service to parishioners. Evidence of this should be provided. Any donation will not normally exceed £350.
- 4) Any National group, club, organisation, which offers facilities of benefit to parishioners, or supplying a charitable service to parishioners. Only those having a local contact point for parishioners will be considered. Evidence of this must be provided. Any donation will not normally exceed £100.

Any group, club or organisation which does not fall into these groups should not apply to avoid unnecessary disappointment of a refusal to award a donation.

In exceptional circumstances the Parish Council can use it's discretion to make donations outside these criteria, but that such instances are expected to be very rare.
