



**DRAYTON (NEAR ABINGDON) - B4017 ABINGDON ROAD:
PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING AND RAISED JUNCTION TABLE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Highways Act 1980, Oxfordshire County Council proposes to install a Zebra crossing at the following location:

- On the **B4017 Abingdon Road** - approximately 12 metres north of its junction with Hilliats Field.

The crossing would be sited on an extended flat top road hump with a nominal height of 50mm and ramp gradients of 1:30 which would be constructed along the B4017 Abingdon Road between (and including) its junctions with Hilliat Fields and a proposed new junction giving access to a proposed new residential development on the east side of the road approximately 30 metres north of the Hilliat Fields junction.
