INTRODUCTION AND RATIONALE

Drayton is currently preparing a Neighbourhood Plan. As part of its evidence gathering process, the Drayton Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group commissioned Oxfordshire Rural Community Council (ORCC) to conduct a residents' survey in July 2013. ORCC is a charity that works with and supports communities across the county and has long-standing expertise in helping communities with consultation strategies.

The survey gave all households in the village the opportunity to express an opinion on multiple themes:

- village design
- housing
- transport
- recreation and play
- work
- education

DISTRIBUTION AND RESPONSE

- Drayton Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group, liaising with ORCC, prepared the survey content.
- The NP Steering Group distributed surveys to 960 parish households in July 2013.
- The NP Steering Group collected surveys from households and returned them to ORCC, which analysed the data and produced this report.
- 612 completed surveys were returned, with 1190 total respondents. According to the 2011 Census, the population of Drayton is 2353. 424 of these were under 14 years-old. Therefore, the respondent rate relative to the over-14 population of Drayton is **62%**.
- The response rate of 612 relative to 960 households is 64%.
- No information is known about the non-respondents, and no assumptions have been made about their housing opinions, needs, or requirements.






1. Do you support the idea of a new Village Green and Community Centre?



4. Which of the following additional facilities would you use if provided in Drayton? 1091 respondents: 2124 total suggestions



6. If you were to move within Drayton in the next 5 years which type of housing would you be most likely to require?




 7. Would anyone in your household be interested in any of the following housing alternatives?



8. Which of the following criteria should be used to assess any housing sites proposed for the village?




















17. Should land in Drayton be used to provide extra employment opportunities (e.g. office development, light industry, craft workshops etc.)?


18. Would you like to work in Drayton (if not already working here) if more job opportunities were available in the village?


19. If small businesses were available in Drayton, would you consider renting one to start up or house your own business?




20. If a suitable area of land was available in Drayton, would you be interested in growing food locally on a smallholding (i.e. land larger than an allotment)?




23. How many people are there in your household in total?

595 responses: total of 1457 people




24. How many of these are children aged 11 and under?

125 responses: total of 203 aged 11 and under




25. What age are you (for members of the household aged 12 and older)?


26. Where do you work (this includes school or college, if applicable)?

27. How many vehicles (in total) are owned by people living at your address?


