

Cumnor

Conservation Area designated 9.7.69, request from Mr and Mrs Eobley Cumnor, to include the village Pond/Bear and Ragged Staff vicinity and extension to Manor Farm/Collge Farm. 19.2.88.

Also Oxfordshire County Council, Museum Services requested that the remains of the gardens of the former monastic grange and Manor House be included.

Prior to the designation of the conservation area in 1969 there had been considerable alteration and infilling in the village and consequently only a small part of the village was included within the conservation area.

Varying the conservation area to include land in the vicinity of Manor Farm and College Farm and the extensive area that includes the remains of the gardens of the former monastic grange and Manor House to the south of St Michael's Church would necessitate the inclusion of open fields which do not contribute to the street scene of Cumnor Village.

There could however be some merit in examining in more detail Appleton Road in the vicinity of the pond and the Bear and Rugged Staff.

That the area and around the village pond on Appleton Road is considered as a conservation area.

Denchworth

Conservation Area designated 22.7.70.

The conservation area currently covers the historic core of the village and is considered satisfactory. No change.

Drayton
