DISTRICT COUNCIL REPORT

General Election

The result of the General Election in the Didcot and Wantage constituency was:

- Olly Glover Liberal Democrat 21,793 (39.8%)
- David Johnston Conservative 15,560 (28.4%)
- Mocky Khan Labour 8,045 (14.7%)
- Steve Beatty Reform 6,400 (11.7%)
- Sam Casey-Rerhaye Green 2,693 (4.9%)
- Kyn Pomlett SDP 242 (0.4%)

Olly Glover was duly elected as MP for Didcot and Wantage, replacing David Johnston.

Electric Vehicle Charging Points at Waste Depot

As we are procuring an EV-waste truck and intend to trial another, two new EV charging points have been installed at the waste depot.

Reservoir

With the change of government, there is an opportunity to request a liaison with the new Secretary of State to discuss the current Thames Water plan and the all-round inadequacy, risk, damage, and unsupportability of the reservoir option. We can redouble attempts at a political solution, and to press for the National Infrastructure Commission's recommendation of water transfers to form a National Water Grid coupled with considerable leakage reduction.

Meanwhile, Thames Water have been carrying out their **"consultation."** It transpires that the designs don't really correspond to what they'd eventually propose, as components are unacceptable in real embankments (eg you cannot have trees on them, as they weaken the structure). They say they intend to actually pursue designing it from winter this year, and still have no answers to flooding, safety risks, issues of filling the reservoir and drawing it down, actual accessibility from the public (despite always claiming it'll be available for leisure use, the security implications of public access to such a strategic asset are huge), and so forth.

Abandoned Vehicles

I've been asked to look into any District Council powers over **abandoned vehicles**. It turns out that responsibilities are shared – to a degree – between the Vale District Council (abandoned vehicles) and OCC (illegally parked vehicles).

DELAY IN HANDOVER

The final stages of handover have been delayed due to a hold up in making District Council planning inspection resource available. The inspection was due to be held in mid-April but is now unlikely to take place until late August or early September.

As a result, it will be late September at the earliest before the residents are likely to secure control of the Management Company (the organisation that will take on responsibility for maintaining the Public Open Space after handover).

On other matters, the Residents' Association has secured support for its Resident Director nominees and has selected a new Managing Agent (Saxons Block Management) to take on day-to-day responsibility for running the Management Company after handover. Both of these will need to be formalised at the EGM, which will also now be delayed until late September.

To give residents some confidence in our new Managing Agent, an all-residents meeting has been organised for Friday 2nd August to be held in the Village Hall. The meeting will start at **2pm** and is scheduled to conclude by 3pm.

Bloor Homes has installed the majority of the bird and bat boxes offered to residents. No new arrivals have been reported just yet, but we are hoping that word will get around in the wildlife community and they may get some attention early next year.




OXTRAIL 2024

PARISH COUNCIL REPORT



The Parish Council met on 9th July

Walnut Meadows

At last, we are making some progress with the development of the sports facilities.

The PC has accepted a bid for the construction of the Multi-use games area (MUGA). Construction work should be starting **September/October**. The construction work for the sports pitches is out for tender **(closing 15th July).**

The Parish Caretaker has been asked to undertake some repairs to the Heras fencing around the site following a complaint from a resident.

Traffic calming

Another meeting has been held with Milestone (OCC contractor). We are working to implement the priority schemes (new crossings on the High St and at the Walnut Meadow junction, new raised platform at Walnut Meadow, adjustment to Sutton Wick junction and work at the Hilliat Fields crossing).

Disappointingly we have been considerably delayed by lack of staffing within OCC, meantime costs have risen significantly and there will be very little money to do anything other than implement our highest priorities.

Work is unlikely to start before **2025**.

Footpath to Milton

When the golf course was built the footpath was diverted so that it did not cross the centre of the course. Subsequently the golf course put up a fence where a gate should have been. The path beyond this point is a permissive footpath within Milton Parish. Drayton PC have, over the past couple of years tried to get agreement from the owners of the land to re-establish access to this permitted path and we are currently trying to negotiate this again.

Footpaths/Trails

We are proposing to mark trails for 4 footpaths of various lengths within the village. We are planning to support the paths with a map, markers and art works on each path.

Grass cutting

The PC is responsible for an increasing amount of grass cutting. We will be reviewing these areas with the aim of developing wild flower zones/ wild areas within the village.

There are two reasons for this review, firstly to ensure we keep a close eye on costs, but secondly and importantly, to identify areas where we can improve biodiversity. It would be really helpful if you could send us comments with regard to areas where we can safely improve wildlife and bio-diversity.

Sutton Wick Pond

We are, as you know, hoping to improve the condition of the pond at Sutton Wick. Additionally, we are planning to pollard the 3 Willow Trees alongside the pond and have obtained three quotes for this work.

Bird and Bat boxes

At the time of writing, we have a number of boxes to donate to anyone within the village. These are sturdy boxes that require fixing to a solid surface. If you would like one, please contact <u>deputydraytonclerk@gmail.com</u>



Firstly we would like to thank **Gillian** for organising a visit to the War Graves in **Botley Cemetery**.

It was the most amazing place—so beautiful yet so sad. For some context, there are over **360** graves from the two world wars alone. A large area is filled with graves, all arranged in neat rows. laid front to back rather than side to side but all in straight lines. This area contains all British service personnel, buried at the regulation eight feet down. There is a very small section for one military nurse and another area on the other side of the path containing over **30** German graves, all similarly maintained by us as they maintain ours in Germany. A German representative visits these graves every year. All graves surround a beautiful, tall white cross. There is also a palatial shelter to sit in and a visitors' book available to sign if you wish. We were taken around by an official War Graves quide for a small fee, but it was so worth it. Such a beautiful, serene place for those brave people.



GARD NEWSLETTER

Election

We are very grateful to Steventon Parish Council and Councillor Sally Povolotsky for organising the Election Hustings event focussing on the Reservoir. This, and the similar events in Didcot (organised by BBOWT) and Abingdon (organised by the Church in Abingdon) helped make the Reservoir a local election issue.

All candidates called for a Public Inquiry and the overwhelming majority slammed the Reservoir proposals.

Now we have a new Secretary of State for DEFRA, Steve Reed, GARD has renewed our call to the new SoS for a Public Inquiry, on his desk on 5th July. We urge every resident and council to similarly write and try to achieve the PI. Please copy to our new MP, Olly Glover, who has been a firm advocate for our cause.

Oxfordshire County Council – 'no confidence in Thames Water'

On Tuesday 9th July, the County Council debated a critical motion on Thames Water's performance (Sewage and Leakage) and on its proposals for the Reservoir. The motion was proposed by Councillor Sally P, and was overwhelmingly carried, with calls for, amongst other things, a statement of opposition to the Reservoir and a call for a Public Inquiry. The motion was passed overwhelmingly. We thank the County Council for their continued support.

New 'Consultation'

Many of you have turned up to Thames Water's PR events to promote the Reservoir consultation. GARD had a presence at the events in Ardington and Didcot, and thanks to those who stopped by and offered support and asked for information. As one resident put it, ".. it was good to see you there with your realistic view, to counteract the pure fantasy of the Thames Water pictures and VR!".

Please remember to respond to the consultation by 27th August. Look out for our information (to be distributed by email to members and supporters, and via Facebook links to the rest), which will give you the most important points on which to oppose the plans.

Note that Thames Water have just signed up new engineering partners (Arup and Binnies) for pushing the reservoir design forward. This means that all the designs they have shown to date, will be completely revised, and all the statements from the engineers you may have met at the events have no ongoing weight and validity.

GARD's experts are clear that the ideas for 'treelined' embankments and 'floating islands' will not survive the engineering focus of the new firms who actually have to be responsible for the consequences of the design. All this redesign will mean more cost inflation. In spite of Thames Water's attempts to hide the cost of £2.7 Billion.

Please, if you have not already done so, sign our petition calling for a Public Inquiry at: https://you.38degrees.org.uk/p/stopTWreservoir.

We intend to send this petition to the new Secretary of State, at the end of the Thames Water 'consultation' on 27th August.
